
Residential & Retail Development, Manor Road, Beverley



The project consisted of a mixed retail and residential development close to the centre of Beverley.

There is a ground floor steel frame built off pad footings with a composite concrete first floor. The masonry envelope is founded on suspended ground beams spanning onto the pad foundations. The apartments are timber frame with sole plates fixed to the first floor slab.

Melia Smith & Jones were commissioned to design and detail the sub- and superstructure elements of the building consisting of deep pad foundations, suspended ground floor beams and slabs with a steel frame supporting a composite concrete first floor and to liaise and coordinate with the designers of the timber frame to the apartments.
