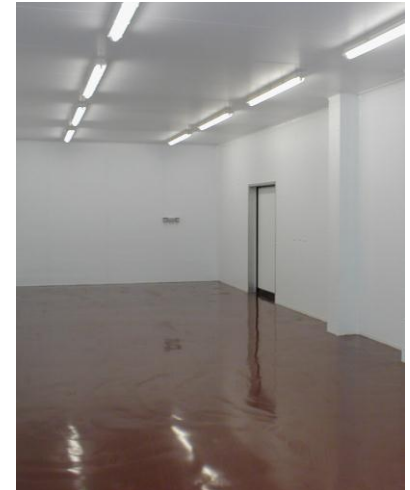

RADU Facility – Seacroft Hospital – Leeds



The project involved the creation of a new refrigeration and distribution unit (RADU) at Seacroft Hospital in Leeds. The building contained cold rooms, freezer rooms, loading bays and associated office space. The structure was a steel frame clad with masonry to match the surrounding buildings. The ground floor was suspended pre-cast concrete on sleeper walls to create the elevated floor necessary for the loading bays.
